SAM TATE HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the portion of SR-53, from the Georgia-Alabama state line in Floyd County, through the cities of Rome, Calhoun, and Gainesville, to the city of Watkinsville, be designated as the Sam Tate Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.

SAM TATE HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the Sam Tate Highway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Colonel Sam Tate, of Tate, Pickens County, Georgia, is one of the most outstanding citizens of the State of Georgia, and

WHEREAS, the said Colonel Sam Tate has been a leader in the State of Georgia, in the advancement of all things contributing to the progress of this State, and

WHEREAS, the said Colonel Sam Tate has most ably served this State as Chairman of the Highway Commission, and

WHEREAS, the said Colonel Sam Tate has contributed greatly both in time and money and is more responsible than any other person for the construction of the road herein mentioned.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF GEORGIA, the Senate concurring, that in honor of the said Colonel Sam Tate and in commemoration of his splendid and lasting service to the State of Georgia, that the highway, from the Georgia-Alabama line in Floyd County, through the cities of Rome, Calhoun, Jasper, Tate, Dawsonville, Gainesville, Hoschton, Braselton, and Winder, to the city of Watkinsville in Oconee County, be designated as the Sam Tate Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the passage of this resolution by the House of Representatives and the Senate, the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall forward to Colonel Sam Tate a certified copy thereof.
