A RESOLUTION

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the portion of US-441, from the Georgia-North Carolina line in Rabun County, through the cities of Clayton, Cornelia, Commerce, Athens, Eatonton, Milledgeville, Dublin, and Douglas, to the Georgia-Florida state line in Echols County, be designated as the Uncle Remus Route.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.
