

## RESOLUTIONS OF THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1980

Adopted October 16, 1980

### JONES LANE MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

#### A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Honorable W. Jones Lane was born in Bulloch County, Georgia and represented that County as a member of the Georgia House of Representatives for the past 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable W. Jones Lane unselfishly served the interests of his constituents and the State and through the years gained the respect and admiration of his colleagues; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable W. Jones Lane served as the Chairman of the Highways Committee in the House of Representatives for six years and in this capacity he was instrumental in the improvement of not only the bridges, streets and highways of the 81st District but also provided the guidance and vision for long range transportation planning for the State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Department of Transportation desires to recognize the Honorable W. Jones Lane's years of dedicated service and devotion to the welfare of the people of the State of Georgia and his support of the Department of Transportation in its efforts to improve transportation within the State.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the State Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to designate State Highway 73/US-301, from the Bulloch-Evans County line, to the Bulloch-Screven County line, as the "Jones Lane Memorial Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect an appropriate plaque or sign implementing this resolution at an appropriate location along the designated State Highway 73, U.S. 301 as provided above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Honorable Thomas D. Moreland, Commissioner of the State Department of Transportation, is directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Mrs. W. Jones Lane along with our deep sympathy for the death of her husband and our heartfelt appreciation for his many years of dedicated service to transportation for the Citizens of the State of Georgia.
