GEORGE S. LEE CAUSEWAY — DESIGNATED.

No. 22 (House Resolution No. 66).

A RESOLUTION

Designating the George S. Lee Causeway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Honorable George S. Lee served with distinction, dedication, and ability as mayor of the City of Omaha, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, he worked tirelessly for over 20 years to get a bridge and causeway built over the Chattahoochee River between Omaha, Georgia, and Cottonton, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Honorable George S. Lee passed away shortly after the bridge was dedicated; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that Honorable George S. Lee be properly remembered for his efforts on behalf of the citizens of his city and state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the causeway which begins on State Route 39 Spur and crosses the Chattahoochee River in Stewart County is designated as the George S. Lee Causeway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate markers at appropriate locations designating such causeway as provided in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the commissioner of transportation and to the family of Honorable George S. Lee.
