

**ACTS AND RESOLUTIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA 1990**

Act 76

House Resolution 592, Part a

Effective April 4, 1990

**U.S. 441 BUSINESS HISTORIC ROUTE — DESIGNATED.**

**A RESOLUTION**

Extending and re-designating the U.S. 441 Business Historic Route; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the construction of U.S. 441 Bypass extending from its intersection with U.S. 441 Business Route in Baldwin to State Route 365 has been completed; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the State Route 365 extension to Toccoa and that portion of U.S. 441 that is common with State Route 365 has been completed to its present terminus at State Route 197 near Clarkesville, and it has been opened to traffic; and

WHEREAS, much of the average daily traffic flow formerly using U.S. 441 through the City of Cornelia has been diverted to the U.S. 441 Bypass; and

WHEREAS, it will be advantageous to the economic welfare of Habersham County, the City of Cornelia, and other municipalities located on U.S. 441, as it existed prior to the construction of U.S. 441 Bypass and State Route 365, to retain as much as possible of the tourist and vacation traffic on U.S. 441 as it previously existed; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Cornelia is in full support of, and joins in, the efforts of Habersham County and the other municipalities located on U.S. 441 extending north from its intersection with U.S. 441 Bypass through Habersham County, as it existed prior to the construction of U.S. 441 Bypass and State Route 365, to preserve the business vitality and historic value of the area along said highway.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the U.S. 441 Business Historic Route be extended to include that portion of US-441 now designated as U.S. 441 Business Route and extending north from the US-441 Bypass in the city of Baldwin, through the city of Cornelia, to State Route 365, as it existed prior to the construction of the US-441 Bypass and State Route 365, and that said portion of U.S. 441 Business Route is designated as part of the U.S. 441 Business Historic Route.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Resolution are repealed.

**U.S. 441 BUSINESS HISTORIC ROUTE — DESIGNATED.**

**A RESOLUTION**

Designating the U. S. 441 Business Historic Route; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the construction of the State Route 365 extension to Toccoa and that portion of U.S. 441 that is common with State Route 365 from its present terminus near Cornelia to State Route 115 at Glade Creek should be completed and ready to open to traffic during mid 1989; and

WHEREAS, that section of U.S. 441 from its terminus with State Route 365 at Glade Creek to existing U.S. 441 in Hollywood should be let to contract and completed during late 1990 or early 1991; and

WHEREAS, when this section of U.S. 441 is opened to traffic, much of the average daily traffic now using the existing U.S. 441 through Demorest and Clarkesville will move to the new highway as has been the case in Tallulah Falls; and

WHEREAS, it will be advantageous to the economic welfare of Habersham County and the surrounding area to retain as much of the tourist and vacation traffic on the existing U.S. 441 as possible; and

WHEREAS, Habersham County, by and through its board of commissioners are in full support of the efforts of the Tri-city Preservation Committee to preserve the business vitality and historic value of the area along U.S. 441 north from State Route 365.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the portion of US-441 North, from State Route 365, to the northern city limits of Clarkesville, is designated as the U.S. 441 Business Historic Route.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate markers so designating said route named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this Resolution to the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation.
