J. P. MARSHALL BY-PASS — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the 441 By-Pass Highway around the City of Eatonton as J. P. Marshall By-Pass; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the Honorable J. P. Marshall is serving in his fifth term as the Mayor of Eatonton; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Marshall, through his exemplary leadership and personal commitment, has led the City of Eatonton through a challenging period of growth and development of a secure place among the outstanding municipalities of this state; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Marshall's foresight and forthright determination have brought unparalleled progress and sense of destiny to the citizens of Eatonton and its surrounding environs; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Marshall's leadership has provided the guidance that has made the Eatonton community a highly desirable place to live, work and play; and

WHEREAS, since Mayor Marshall worked so diligently for the construction of the 441 By-Pass around Eatonton and since such by-pass should lead to greater development to the Eatonton - Putnam County area, it is only fitting and proper that such highway be named in honor of Mayor Marshall.

NOT, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the 441 By-Pass Highway around the City of Eatonton shall be designated as the J. P. Marshall By-Pass.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate markers at appropriate locations designating said highway as provided in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the commissioner of transportation and to Honorable J. P. Marshall.
