

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1992

BLUE STAR HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, the Blue Star Memorial Highway is composed of more than 50,000 miles of roads throughout the United States which have been specially designated and beautified to honor past, present, and future members of this country's Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Star Highway concept began in 1944 and was promoted by the National Council of Garden Clubs; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate at this time to recognize the service and sacrifice of our Armed Forces by designating another section of Georgia's highways for inclusion in this system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the section of State Route 73 (U.S. Route 301) from its intersection with Interstate Highway 16 northward to the South Carolina state line be designated as a Blue Star Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation shall authorize appropriate signing for this designation and that a copy of this resolution be entered in the records of this Board.
