VETERANS MEMORIAL PARKWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Dedicating the Veterans Memorial Parkway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, from the birth of this nation, our citizen soldiers have sacrificed to defend our freedom and way of life; and

WHEREAS, this nation and the State of Georgia owe a debt of gratitude to the men and women of the armed forces who have valiantly defended our nation and the principles of democracy against foreign aggressors; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting that we designate memorials as outward symbols of our inner gratitude to those who have served our state and nation so well.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the portion of US-441, known as the "Commerce Bypass," from 1,500 feet south of the intersection of US-441 and Georgia Highway 334, north for 4.865 miles, is designated as the Veterans Memorial Parkway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facilities named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation.
