

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1990

RIVER WATCH PARKWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has under construction in Richmond County, Georgia, a project designated as MLP-750(4), Murray Road Extension; and

WHEREAS, said project shall be placed on the State Highway System upon its completion and shall be designated State Route 104; and

WHEREAS, the beautiful Savannah River flows along the northern border of Richmond County on its journey to the Atlantic Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the Savannah River has a vital role in transportation for the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the State Transportation Board desires to recognize the proximity of the new State Route to the Savannah River.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the State Transportation Board, that the Department is hereby authorized and directed to designate that portion of State Route 104, which runs from its intersection with State Route 104 Connector/Washington Road to its intersection with State Route 4/13th Street in Richmond County, as the "River Watch Parkway".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect appropriate signs along the designated State Route 104 implementing this Resolution as provided above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Honorable Hall Rives, Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this Resolution to the Chairman of the Richmond County Board of Commissioners and to the Mayor of the City of Augusta.

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1993

RIVER WATCH PARKWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has under construction in Columbia and Richmond Counties, a project designated as MLP-750(6), Murray Road Extension; and

WHEREAS, said project shall be placed on the State Highway System upon its completion and shall be designated State Route 750; and

WHEREAS, the beautiful Savannah River flows along the northern border of Richmond County on its journey to the Atlantic Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the Savannah River has a vital role in transportation for the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the State Transportation Board desires to recognize the proximity of the new State Route to the Savannah River.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that his new highway segment, running from its intersection with Washington Road and Pleasant Home Road to its intersection with State Route 104, shall be known, together with the previously designated segment, as the "River Watch Parkway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signing for this designation, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and that copies be presented to the Columbia County Board of Commissioners, the Richmond County Board of Commissioners, and the Mayor of the City of Augusta.
