

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1993

JAMES MARVIN FLOYD HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, James Marvin Floyd has long been involved in the public and political life of Liberty County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Floyd served for many years as a member of the City Council of Flemington, later as a member of the Liberty County Commission, and since 1984 as a member of the Georgia House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, he has also been an important part of business and civic activities in his community; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that James Marvin Floyd should be publicly honored.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the section of State Route 196 beginning at the Hinesville city limit west of Hinesville and running west through Liberty County to the Long county line be designated as the "James Marvin Floyd Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signing for this designation, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and that copies be presented to Mr. Floyd.
