

RESOLUTIONS BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1993

Adopted March 18, 1993

HOWARD TAMPLIN HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Honorable Howard Tamplin has served the needs of the citizens of Morgan County for many years in both private and public life; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tamplin was born on a farm near the Buckhead community in Morgan County and as a teenager had the responsibility of helping his mother to support his brothers and sisters during the years of the Great Depression; and

WHEREAS, he was elected to the Georgia General Assembly in 1948 and served seven consecutive terms, during which he was chairman of the House Agriculture Committee's Dairy Subcommittee and helped to establish the Milk Control Board to stabilize milk prices; and

WHEREAS, following his years in the General Assembly he served Morgan County as a rural mail carrier and was a popular columnist in the Madisonian newspaper; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that Mr. Tamplin's life and service should be publicly recognized.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the portion of State Route 83, from the northern city limits of Madison, north to the Morgan county line, be designated as the Howard Tamplin Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signing for this designation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy be presented to Mr. Tamplin.
