

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1994

JOHN R. WILLIAMS HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, John R. Williams is one of Georgia's outstanding business leaders; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Williams is a native of the Atlanta area and, since assuming the leadership of the family-owned Williams Brothers Lumber Company in 1949, he has led it to remarkable success in its lumber, concrete, and block enterprises and thereby has contributed much to the growth of the Atlanta area; and

WHEREAS, he has served in leadership roles in the Georgia Chamber of Commerce and the DeKalb and Newton Chambers and as Chairman of the Board for the First National Bank of Newton County; and

WHEREAS, his public involvement has included service as a director for Georgians for Better Transportation and member of the State Natural Resources Board; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that his career and accomplishments should be publicly recognized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the section of State Route 142 from its intersection with State Route 81 southward to its intersection with U.S. Highway 278, located in Newton County, be designated as the "John R. Williams Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to arrange for appropriate signing for this designation, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and that a copy be presented to Mr. Williams.
