

## **A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1994**

### **TOM COLEMAN HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.**

WHEREAS, Senator Torn Coleman of Savannah has represented the people of the First Senatorial District and Chatham County for seven consecutive terms since his first election in 1980; and

WHEREAS, Senator Coleman has served the State and his constituents in a variety of committee assignments including Appropriations, Banking and Financial Institutions, Health and Human Services, and numerous interim study committees; and

WHEREAS, his leadership has been especially noteworthy in the field of transportation policy, with his chairmanship of the Senate Transportation Committee and membership on the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority Overview Committee; and

WHEREAS, Tom Coleman has served the people in countless other areas, including service as an officer in the United States Army during the Korean War, as an alderman in Savannah's city government from 1961 to 1966, and as chairman of the Chatham County Commission from 1973 to 1977; and

WHEREAS, he is also a successful businessman in the construction industry, has been chairman of the Savannah Area Chamber of Commerce, and has served as director of the Georgia Tech Athletic Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the section of Interstate Highway 95 within Chatham County shall be designated the "Tom Coleman Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to arrange for appropriate signing for this designation, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and that a copy be presented to Senator Coleman.
