JAMES EDWIN "FAT" GODLEY BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Honorable James Edwin "Fat" Godley has served the people of Camden County and the State of Georgia for many years in a faithful and honorable manner; and

WHEREAS, his long career of public service has included thirty-two years as County Court Clerk in Camden County and thirty-two years as Clerk of the Camden County Board of Commissioners, as well as three years of service in the U.S. Army during World War II; and

WHEREAS, his work as a Transportation Planner in District Five since 1979 has been invaluable to the Department of Transportation and to this Board in developing transportation improvements throughout Southeast Georgia; and

WHEREAS, he has also given thousands of hours of his time as a volunteer at Cumberland Island National Seashore, leading tours of Plum Orchard for countless visitors including members of this Board; and

WHEREAS, he has been throughout the years a valued friend and advisor to this Board and to the management of the Department.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the bridge on State Route 25/US-17 in Camden County, over the Satilla River, be designated as the "James Edwin 'Fat' Godley Bridge."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signing for this designation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy be presented to Mr. Godley.
