E. L. MASSEY, JR. BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, E. L. Massey, Jr. has been an active citizen and leader in Terrell County throughout his life; and

WHEREAS, he has served as a City Council Member and Mayor of Bronwood, and as the First Chief of the Bronwood Volunteer Fire Department, which he was instrumental in forming; and

WHEREAS, he is an active member of Bronwood Buddies, an organization dedicated to making improvements in the downtown area of Bronwood; and

WHEREAS, he was one of the organizers of the Bronwood Civitan Club and has held every local office in that organization in addition to serving as its District Governor, Lt. Governor, Deputy Governor, and Chaplin; and

WHEREAS, he has helped boost Southwest Georgia through his association with the Dawson News and by representing Terrell County on the Southwest Georgia Private & Industry Committee; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Massey's active, life-long membership in the Bronwood Methodist Church, and his assistance in the founding of the Terrell County Camp of Gideon International has enhanced the moral and spiritual values of Terrell County, while his example as a husband, father, and grandfather has provided a role-model for current generations.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the bridge on State Route 118, at the Lee-Terrell County line, over the Kinchafoonee Creek, be designated as the "E. L. Massey, Jr. Bridge."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signing for this designation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy be presented to Mr. Massey.
