

# RESOLUTIONS BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1999

Adopted May 20, 1999

## MONTICELLO CROSSROADS SCENIC BYWAY — DESIGNATED.

### A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Development Authority of Jasper County has applied for Georgia Scenic Byway designation for a 29-mile route traversing State roads in Jasper County; and

WHEREAS, this route possesses four of the six possible Scenic Byway intrinsic qualities - scenic, natural, historic, and recreational; and

WHEREAS, the Development Authority of Jasper County has worked with the citizens, organizations and local governments in the proposed byway area to develop a route and prepare a Corridor Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the locally-approved Corridor Management Plan identifies actions to protect and enhance the Scenic Byway features; and

WHEREAS, Section 1047 of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) established a Scenic Byways Program under Title 23, United States Code. And the Transportation Equity Act For the 21st Century (TEA-21) continues the program as amended in Section 1219; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation is the designated Scenic Byway Agency for the State of Georgia.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the following route be designated as a Georgia Scenic Byway, and be designated as the "Monticello Crossroads Scenic Byway."

- On SR-11, from the Jasper-Newton County line, to SR-83 in the city of Monticello; then
- On SR-83, through the city of Shady Dale in Jasper County, to the Jasper-Morgan County line.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signing for this designation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.
