House Resolution 838, Part IV

Effective May 16, 2002

**TALMADGE PLAZA — DESIGNATED.**

**A RESOLUTION**

Dedicating the Talmadge Plaza; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the late Herman Talmadge was one of Georgia's most distinguished citizens who served as Governor of the State of Georgia and as a United States Senator and who passed away on March 21, 2002.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the brick-paved area surrounding the statue of the late Governor Herman Talmadge near Washington Street (across the street from the State Capitol), is designated in Governor Talmadge's honor as Talmadge Plaza.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the plaza is described as follows:

- beginning at the western side of Washington Street, approximately 110 feet from the intersection of Washington Street Mitchell Street; then
- northwest for approximately 112 feet; then
- northeast for approximately 128 feet; then
- southeast for approximately 112 feet, to Washington Street; then
- southwest on Washington Street for approximately 128 feet, to the beginning point.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation.
