MIA/KIA BRYANT H. ROBERTS, SFC MEMORIAL BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Dedicating certain portions of the state highway system; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, SFC Bryant H. Roberts was born on January 30, 1920, and served his country in 1942, in the United States Navy aboard the U.S.S. Vincennes during World War II; and

WHEREAS, he made the ultimate sacrifice for his country in the name of freedom for all Americans when he was lost at sea in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Berrien County deems it fitting and appropriate to honor the service and sacrifice of SFC Bryant H. Roberts by designating a permanent public memorial near his homeplace.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the members of this body join in dedicating the bridge over the Ten Mile Creek on SR 168 near Nashville in Berrien County as the MIA/KIA Bryant H. Roberts, SFC Memorial Bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facilities named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation and the family of Bryant H. Roberts.
