SENATOR HORACENA E. TATE INTERCHANGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Dedicating certain portions of the state highway system; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Senator Horacena E. Tate has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital role that she plays in leadership in this state and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Senator Tate graduated from Frederick Douglass High School, earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Georgia, a master's degree from Atlanta University Center, and a Doctor of Education degree from Clark Atlanta University; and

WHEREAS, succeeding her father, the late State Senator Dr. Horace Tate, she served with distinction as the Georgia State Senator for District 38, representing portions of Fulton and Cobb Counties, from 1998 to 2024; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure with the Senate that spanned over two decades, Senator Tate served as member of the Senate Appropriations, Education and Youth, Rules, Reapportionment and Redistricting, State and Local Governmental Operations, and Urban Affairs Committees; and

WHEREAS, her leadership and service has been recognized with numerous awards, including Legislator of the Year from the National Association of Social Workers Georgia Chapter; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an interchange in her honor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the interchange at State Route 402/I-20 and State Route 407/I-285 in Fulton County, is dedicated as the Senator Horacena E. Tate Interchange.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to make appropriate copies of this Resolution available for distribution to the Department of Transportation and to Senator Horacena E. Tate.
